Please note non-payment and resignation policies:

Article IV of our By-Laws provides that a member who fails to pay any obligation due the Congregation within 6 months after such obligation is due may be suspended and deprived of all membership rights and privileges. If your financial situation worsens during this membership year, please contact TBC as soon as possible to discuss special dues arrangements regarding your outstanding obligations. If deemed necessary, we can revise your financial commitments to TBC to ensure that you remain a member in good standing.

Article IV also provides that the resignation of any member shall not relieve the member from the payment of any obligation due to the Congregation at the time of resignation. Any unpaid obligations, including those previously arranged to be paid in installments, are due immediately upon the member's resignation. Any pre-paid obligations are forfeited to the Temple at the time of resignation and not eligible for reimbursement. TBC does not pro-rate dues and school tuition for members who leave the Temple during the middle of the fiscal year.

A member's account must be in good standing prior to renewal of membership. Thus, any outstanding charges from the previous fiscal year must be paid in full before renewal of membership can be processed.

In order to have a Bar or Bat Mitzvah date assigned for a student, the family must be in good standing.

If a family is renting the social hall for any occasion including B'nai Mitzvah, all associated fees for the social hall rental must be paid in advance of the event.

Payment Options

a. Payment Options

If you are choosing the New Member Family rate of \$3,600 you have two payment options for the dues,

- 1) all at once upon registration or
- 2) \$1800 upon registration and \$1800 no later than January 15, 2026

If you are **choosing a higher dues level**, you also have the option to spread the payments out either quarterly or in 10 increments. The Automatic Withdrawal Authorization form included on the next page is used to set up those payment structures.

School tuition, capital fund payments, security payments and other optional payments are paid annually regardless of the level of dues you select.
